Services Provided by MRRAEP

Adult Basic Education (ABE) Programs consist of instruction that provides basic skills for adults who are performing below the ninth grade level in reading, writing, mathematics, and other basic skills.

English as a Second Language (ESL) Programs consist of instruction designed to increase the English proficiency of limited English-speaking (LEP) adults in reading, writing, speaking, and listening. Many programs also include civics related instructional activities such as health, family, and financial literacy.

General Educational Development Diploma (GED)

The GED testing program is jointly administered by the GED Testing Service (GEDTS) of the American Council on Education and by the Virginia Department of Technical and Adult Education Office of Adult Literacy. The GED battery of tests is developed by GEDTS and the same tests are given in all fifty states.

Transition Classes – accelerated instruction in reading, writing and math for individuals who possess a GED and desire to enroll in college credit-bearing classes

Transition Classes are currently in session at Virginia Highlands Community College and Wytheville Community College.

GED Testing for Washington, Smyth and Bristol

Background: MRRAEP has been in existence for fourteen years. The program serves the Virginia counties of Washington, Smyth, Bland, Grayson and Wythe and the cities of Bristol and Galax. We provide leadership and support for adult education and literacy services with emphasis on the development and expansion of quality family literacy and workplace education programs. Our core services include Adult Basic Education, Adult Secondary and English as a Second Language. Washington County Public Schools serves as the fiscal agent for this program; however, the regional office is located on the Virginia Highlands Community College Campus.

Eligibility: Individuals must be 18 years of age. We are able to serve individuals as young as 16 if they show proof of release from compulsory school attendance from their local school board.
